DAY 1 • SEPTEMBER 26

Depart the USA for Florence, Italy. Travel to Chicago O'Hare via Van Galder bus or arrange your own transportation to the airport.

DAY 2 • SEPTEMBER 27 • (CINQUE TERRE)

After our arrival in Florence, transfer to our hotel in the Cinque Terre. Welcome dinner at hotel. (D)

DAY 3 • SEPTEMBER 28 • (CINQUE TERRE)

Following breakfast at our hotel, we'll orient you to the eclectic collection of Cinque Terre villages and the walking paths that connect them. Spend the remainder of the day hiking the scenic paths, enjoying the dramatic views from a boat, or simply relaxing at a local beach. (B)

DAY 4 • SEPTEMBER 29 • (CINQUE TERRE)

Take the full day to venture out and discover the charms of these adjoining villages. The day is yours to visit and explore the seaside, sample the local cuisine and wine, and enjoy the spectacular sunset. (B)

DAY 5 • SEPTEMBER 30 • (TUSCANY/LUCCA/FIESOLE)

Following breakfast, travel to our hotel in the countryside, just outside Florence. On the way, we'll stop in Lucca – a beautiful walled Tuscan town that boasts some of Italy's finest medieval architecture. Enjoy a special welcome dinner on the

hotel's terrace overlooking the city of Florence. (B,D)

DAY 6 • OCTOBER 1 • (FIESOLE/ FLORENCE)

Enjoy a leisurely breakfast at our hotel. Later, behold the many sights of Florence, birthplace of the Italian Renaissance, on a half-day tour. Wander the Uffizi Gallery, stand in the shadow of the towering Brunelleschi's Dome and of course, enjoy Michelangelo's David up close. The remainder of the day is yours to relax and explore Florence on your own. (B)

DAY 7 • OCTOBER 2 • (CASTELLINA IN CHIANTI, SAN GIMIGNANO)

After breakfast, we drive south to Castellina in Chianti and San Gimignano, taking in Tuscany's patchwork landscape of churches, vineyards, olive groves and cypress trees. Lunch and dinner on your own. (B)

DAY 8 • OCTOBER 3 • (CERTALDO)

Following breakfast, travel to scenic Certaldo to experience the Boccaccesca Food and Wine Festival. Spend the day sampling pork, olive oil, bread, and other gastronomic specialties, including award-winning wines. Watch local craftsmen practice their trade during culinary demonstrations and competitions. After a day of feasting, return to our hotel. (B)

DAY 9 • OCTOBER 4 • (FIESOLE/AREZZO)

After breakfast at the hotel, travel to Arezzo, a charming small town where Benigni's film, "Life is Beautiful" was filmed. Later, visit Il Borro, a luxury wine estate restored by the Ferragamo family, for a tour and wine tasting. Lunch at the estate's osteria. Evening on your own. (B)

DAY 10 • OCTOBER 5 • (FIESOLE/FLORENCE)

Spend your final day relaxing poolside at the villa, wandering the quaint town of Fiesole or return to Florence. Later we'll gather together for a farewell dinner, specially prepared for us at a charming nearby restaurant. (B,D)

DAY 11 • OCTOBER 6 • (FLORENCE TO CHICAGO)

Following breakfast, say a reluctant "Ciao" to Italy and depart for your return flight from Florence to Chicago. (B)

RESERVATIONS AND PAYMENT: Prices are based on double occupancy. A deposit of \$600 per person is required to reserve space (due May 1, 2010). Balance is due June 15, 2010. Payment must be made by check.

BAGGAGE: Due to limited motorcoach capacity on the land portion of the tour, transportation and portage of one suitcase per person will be accepted. The organizers of the tour accept no liability for loss or damage to luggage, although maximum care will be taken to insure safe handling of your luggage.

CANCELLATIONS All cancellations must be received in writing. For cancellations received on or before May 30, 2010, a fee of \$300 per person will be charged. For cancellations received between June 1 and June 30, 2010, a cancellation fee of \$600 per person will be charged. For cancellations received between July 1 and July 20, 2010, a cancellation fee of 50% of the tour price will be charged. There is NO REFUND for cancellations received on or after July 21, 2010.

INSURANCE: Personal trip cancellation, travel accident and baggage insurance is strongly recommended.
