FRIDAY, MAY 14 • DEPART

Depart USA for Florence. Leave from Chicago O'Hare or another USA airport.

SATURDAY, MAY 15 • FLORENCE

After our arrival in Florence, transfer to our hotel outside Florence. Enjoy a welcome dinner at hotel. (D)

SUNDAY, MAY 16 • FLORENCE

Enjoy a leisurely breakfast at our hotel overlooking the city of Florence. Later, behold the many sights of Florence, birthplace of the Italian Renaissance, on a half-day tour. Wander the Uffizi Gallery, stand in the shadow of the towering Brunelleschi's Dome and of course, enjoy Michelangelo's David up close. The remainder of the day is yours to relax and explore Florence on your own. (B)

MONDAY, MAY 17 • FLORENCE

We'll leave our hotel/villa and drive to one of Tuscany's most beautiful hill towns, San Gimignano. On our way, we'll visit Castellina in Chianti, a 15th century Tuscan village. Spend the afternoon/evening exploring San Gimignano on your own. (B)

TUESDAY, MAY 18 • BUON CONVENTO

After breakfast at the hotel, travel to a small boutique winery near Montalcino to taste their impressive wines. Later, wander the streets of the Tuscan hill town Montalcino and enjoy lunch or dinner at one of its award-winning restaurants. (B)

WEDNESDAY, MAY 19 • BUON CONVENTO

After breakfast, visit Montepulciano — and sample its famed wine, "Vino di Nobile". Continue to explore the Tuscan countryside with a stop in Pienza — a town that represents one of the best planned Renaissance towns and boasts some of the best pecorino cheese in Italy. (B)

THURSDAY, MAY 20 • BUON CONVENTO

After breakfast, discover the hidden treasures of the Tuscan coastline and the aboard a 38-foot Swedish sailboat. (Note: the Mediterranean cruise is optional* and available to a limited number of guests.) Or choose to relax at our B&B and enjoy the breathtaking views of the Tuscan countryside. (B)

FRIDAY, MAY 21 • POMPEII/AMALFI

Enjoy a leisurely breakfast and travel to southern Italy and the stunning Amalfi Coast. On the way, gain insight into the life of a city at the height of the Roman Empire with a stop and guided tour of Pompeii. Evening on your own to relax and take in the scenic beauty of the coast. (B)

SATURDAY, MAY 22 • AMALFI

After breakfast, participate in an optional* cooking class and lunch in Ravello, a town that sits high above the Amalfi coast. Cook alongside the famed Mamma Agata—who once cooked for American celebrities such as Frank Sinatra and Jacqueline Kennedy—and learn the secrets of cooking with fresh regional ingredients. Enjoy the results with lunch on a terrace that boasts some of the best views of the coast. Spend the rest of the day relaxing along the coast, dining and walking. Evening on your own. (B)

SUNDAY, MAY 23 • AMALFI/CAPRI

Travel by boat to Capri, the Bay of Naples' most beautiful island, for an escorted trip including the Blue Grotto. (weather permitting). Return to Amalfi and spend the remainder of the day exploring on your own, taking in the sapphire bays and spectacular vistas. (B)

MONDAY, MAY 24 • AMALFI

Spend your final day along the coast, relaxing at the beach, or enjoying a meal at one of the seaside restaurants. (B)

TUESDAY, MAY 25 • FRASCATI/ROME

Leave Amalfi and travel to Frascati, a town outside Rome, known for its white wine. After our arrival, enjoy the evening relaxing at our splendid country villa — or explore Frascati and its restaurants and wine bars. (B)

WEDNESDAY, MAY 26 • FRASCATI/ROME

Spend the day exploring the fascinating history of Rome that spans more than two and a half thousand years. Visit the impressive sights of the Colosseum, St. Peter's Square, the Vatican and the Trevi fountain. Evening on your own. (B)

THURSDAY, MAY 27 • ROME

Spend our last full day exploring on your own — shopping in Frascati, a return trip to Rome, or by relaxing at our countryside villa. Later, we'll celebrate our Italian experience together with a farewell dinner. (B,D)

FRIDAY, MAY 28 • ROME

Say a reluctant "Ciao" to Italy. Enjoy a final leisurely breakfast before our transfer to the airport for a return flight to the U.S.

RESERVATIONS AND PAYMENT: Prices are based on double occupancy. A deposit of \$750 per person is required to reserve space (due February 1, 2010). Balance is due March 1, 2010. Payment must be made by check.

BAGGAGE: Due to limited motorcoach capacity on the land portion of the tour, transportation and portage of one suitcase per person will be accepted. The organizers of the tour accept no liability for loss or damage to luggage, although maximum care will be taken to insure safe handling of your luggage.

CANCELLATIONS All cancellations must be received in writing. For cancellations received on or before February, 2010, a fee of \$375 per person will be charged. For cancellations received between February 15 and April 1, 2010, a cancellation fee of \$750 per person will be charged. For cancellations received between April 1 and May 1, 2010, a cancellation fee of 50% of the tour price will be charged. There is NO REFUND for cancellations received on or after May 1, 2010.

INSURANCE: Personal trip cancellation, travel accident and baggage insurance is strongly recommended.

PRICES Rates are those in effect at the time of printing (Jan. 2010), and are subject to change without notice due to increase in hotel and government taxes, currency exchange fluctuations and airfares.
